MINUTES VMNH Facilities Committee 24 September 2020, via Zoom

- I. Wecome
 - Barry Dorsey began the meeting at 3:00PM.
- II. VMNH passenger elevator
 - Tim King gave an overview of elevator repairs and costs.
 - Two quotes were received
 - Barry asked Tim if he felt good about Roman, and Tim replied "Yes."
 - Jonathan Martin confirmed we had maintenance reserve funds available.
 - Lisa Moerner made the motion to replace the elevator system, and Cord Cothren seconded. All voted in favor, and Jennifer Burnett abstained because of a client relationship.
- III. Energy savings
 - Jonathan Martin gave a report that we will be funded through the Department of Mines, Minerals, and Energy to upgrade building systems (e.g., LED lights, updates/replacements of boilers and chillers, solar panels, insulation) working with an outside firm.
 - Lisa Moerner asked that we get confirmation that there is a plan for end of life costs for any solar panels, and that some models of solar panels, particularly those that are made in some other countries, have a lot of hazardous materials.
 - Lisa Moerner will help review the proposals.
 - The committee asked that staff bring a progress report back to them with a recommendation, and the facilities committee will present to the full board in November.
 - (Jonathan Martin subsequently confirmed that any solar panels bought through this grant program must be made in America)
- IV. Jonathan Martin gave a report on the Jean S. Adams Education Pavilion. All paperwork and plans have been submitted and we are awaiting the go-ahead so the architect can engage with a contractor.
- V. Barry Dorsey concluded the meeting, and Lisa Moerner made a motion to adjourn at 3:45PM, and Jennifer Burnett seconded. The vote was unanimous.
